

Workshop on Research Methodology (Series IV): Planning & Implementation of Research

This workshop series is designed to enable health personnel to conceptualize the health related research and to conduct research independently. The workshop series is composed of 10 independent (one day) sessions. Each workshop session focuses on individual domain of Epidemiology.

In current session instruction will be provided on how to plan & implement research projects using concepts of research methods, questionnaire development, pre-testing and validation, formation of field research team & task distribution, data collection and analysing of data as well as interpretation, details on sampling methods and calculation of the sample size and report preparation & dissemination for a study. The workshop will help the health personnel involved in teaching for conceptualizing research methods which will eventually help them in teaching as well as guiding/supervising students' thesis or dissertation. For NGO professionals, the course will be particularly helpful as the course will enable them to design, evaluate, plan and conduct research independently. Young researchers as well as student researchers will be benefited in conducting their thesis and dissertation.
